THEME: TWILIGHT GARDEN

A fabric or paper identification LABEL must be securely fastened to a bottom back corner. The label must contain the same name and address that appears on the entry form. The quilt perimeter must be 72" or less. A recognizable mount of challenge fabric must be used as an integral part of the entry.

CATEGORIES, Categories: Open-Whatever you choose! FOR EXAMPLE:

Appliqué

Crazy Patch

Embellishment

Innovative Mixed Technique: Two or more dominant Techniques including (but not limited) to appliqué, piecing, embroidery, dyeing, embellishment, painting, machine quilting, and hand quilted.

Innovative Pieced: Techniques can include curves, landscapes, off-kilter versions of traditional blocks, three dimensional piecing and tessellations.

Machine or Hand Quilted

Pictorial: The quilt is representation of a person, place or thing.

Traditional Mixed Technique: Two or more dominant traditional techniques including (but not limited to) appliqué, piecing, embroidery, machine quilting, and hand quilting.

Traditional Piecing: The predominant technique is piecing using traditional block pattern.
